



**ROAD TRAFFIC ACTS 1993 – 2023
PUBLIC TRANSPORT REGULATION ACT, 2009
TRAFFIC CALMING SCHEMES
BALBRIGGAN / RUSH / LUSK / SWORDS
OPERATIONAL AREA**

Fingal County Council in exercise of the powers conferred on it under Section 38 of the Road Traffic Act, 1994 and Section 46 of the Public Transport Regulation Act, 2009 hereby gives notice that it has prepared Scheme for the provision of traffic calming measures at the following location:

Chapel Green, Rush, Co Dublin – In the interests of road safety and convenience for all road users, Fingal County Council is proposing to change the existing two-way traffic flow into a one-way traffic flow on a section of Chapel Green, Rush, Co. Dublin.

The one-way section will apply from the junction of Chapel Green/Whitestown Road to a point approximately 80 meters southeast to the Chapel Green junction with the local car park entrance.

The scheme provides for one-way traffic, new signalized junction, parking, appropriate road signage and markings where necessary.
