



APPLICATIONS FOR CASUAL TRADING SUPPLEMENTARY TRADING PERIOD 01ST JULY 2022 – 28TH FEBRUARY 2023

Fingal County Council has designated Casual Trading Areas under the Casual Trading Byelaws 2021 which allows for the sale of specified goods at a place (including a public road) to which the public have access as of right and any other place that is a designated Casual Trading Area.

Fingal County Council seeks applications from interested traders for a Supplementary Casual Trading period to run from 01st July 2022 to 28th February 2023. The annual licence fees will be pro-rata for this 9-month period.

Completed applications should be received **no later than 5pm on 24th June 2022** either to CasualTrading@fingal.ie or by post to Casual Trading (Supplementary Period), Operations Department, Fingal County Council, Grove Road, Blanchardstown, Dublin 15.
