## Chief Executive's Message



**F**ingal County Council's 2019 Budget provides for an increased level of investment in the social, economic and cultural fabric of this County. The overall aim of the Budget is to maintain and build

on the enhanced investment undertaken in recent years.

Meeting the demands for increased levels of service and investment, in what is the fastest growing county in Ireland, remains a significant challenge. This Budget will support the Council in maintaining and improving the services that we deliver to all of our key stakeholders.

The 2019 Budget will also have an impact of €572m on the local economy, an increase of €61m since 2017. In simple terms this means that for each €1 of Fingal County Council current and capital expenditure, there is resultant economic output of €1.73 across the economy.

Increased income from commercial rates and the Local Property Tax adjustment has been ring-fenced in the Budget for investment in operations, tourism, events, community, and the arts, and also to assist with tackling homelessness. Fingal County Council will continue to invest in the social, economic and cultural fabric of this county to ensure that Fingal is the place of choice to live, work, visit and do business.

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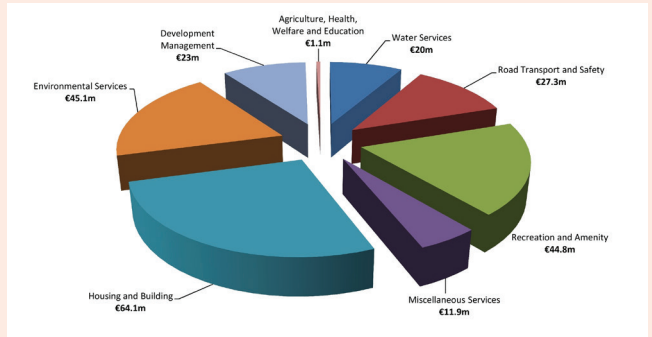
# €237m budget approved for 2019

Fingal County Council will spend €237m, the equivalent of €801 per head of population, in 2019 to provide services and investment which aim to improve the county as a place in which to live, work and invest.

Since 2012, the revenue Budget has increased from €212m to €237, an increase of over 10 per cent. The 2019 budget includes a €10m increase in expenditure on 2018 budget, which itself contained a €10m spending increase on 2017.

Three key core objectives have been set out in the Budget as Fingal County Council lays out its plan for the year ahead. The main priority is to continue investment in the Housing and Community areas. Furthermore, it will maintain the Council's enhanced level of investment to improve service delivery, as well as developing the economic and community plan for Fingal that supports job creation, tourism and sustainable communities.

Furthermore, under its three-year Capital Programme



2019-2021 agreed in October, Fingal County Council will spend a further €588.68m on 212 individual projects across the county.

The €237m budget, agreed by councillors, breaks down as follows:

- €64.1m - Housing and Building
- €27m - Road Transport and Safety
- €20m Water Services
- €23m - Development Management
- €45.1m - Environmental Services
- €44.9m Recreation and Amenity
- €1.1m - Agriculture, Health, Welfare and Education
- €11.9m - Miscellaneous Services

Councillors agreed to a two per cent commercial rates increase which will see €2.5m

ring-fenced for additional investment in street cleaning, parks maintenance and other operational activities.

Some €400,000 will be allocated to community centres for remedial and refurbishment works. A further €700,000 has been allowed for enhanced investment in community events and facilities. The Arts Office will receive €0.25m for additional investment in arts facilities, grants and activities, while €850,000 has been earmarked for enhanced expenditure in events, tourism activities and heritage properties

In September, councillors agreed to reduce the Local Property Tax by 5% which has allowed €2m to be set aside for housing and homelessness and local services.

# AMBITIOUS STRATEGY PROVIDES SOLID FOUNDATION FOR FINGAL TO THRIVE

Fingal County Council has increased spending by over €20m in the past two years, bringing its overall expenditure to €237m in 2019, as part of an ambitious and far-reaching strategy to provide a solid foundation for the region to thrive as a place to live, visit and do business.

That's according to Head of Finance Oliver Hunt, *(pictured)* who looks after the local authority's purse strings on a day to day basis, and who said that Budget 2019 will maintain and build on the enhanced investment undertaken in the 2018 Budget.

Fingal County Council's annual Budget has been steadily increasing in recent years, rising from €216m in 2017 to €237m this year, an increase of 10 per cent.

Mr Hunt said that Fingal



County Council has been rebuilding its finances to allow for greater and more substantial investment in the region. "In 2018, we increased our expenditure by €10m and in 2019, we have a further additional €10m to invest."

Mr Hunt said: "Last year, we began a two-year strategy to provide for substantial investment in the region. We kicked off in 2018 with the LPT adjustment which provided for an additional €2m in funding which was ring-fenced for a number of

key areas.

"We also looked at rates, which had seen substantial rates reductions in the early part of the decade as we supported businesses in a difficult economic environment. The economy has improved dramatically since then. This additional money was earmarked for a number of projects such as public lighting, traffic, footpaths, remedial and refurbishment works on community centres and to provide funds for capital works for our housing stock including heating system upgrades and other remedial works."

And now in 2019, Fingal County Council will continue with the strategy, building on that work through the LPT adjustment and rates increase, which will provide



for an additional €2.5m in funding, which again has been ring-fenced for a number of key projects across the region .

The money has been set aside for very specific activities in the areas of housing and homelessness, community, operations, tourism and events, including our heritage properties, as well as libraries.

He said: “These are key areas from our citizens point of view, they are forward-facing type of activities. The feedback has been very positive as you could clearly see where the money was spent. For example Flavours of Fingal was one of these

areas and that was a very successful event during the summer.

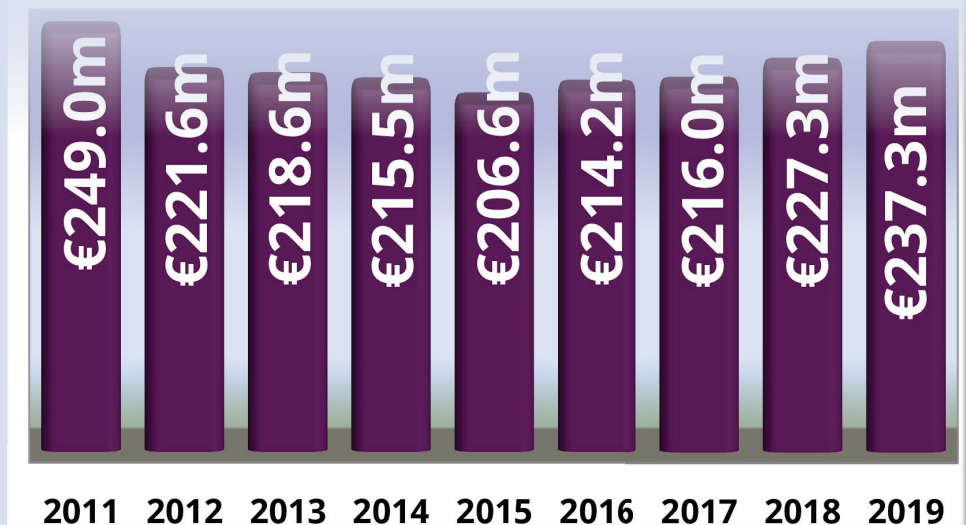
Mr Hunt said: “The basis of the strategy is to allow for investment in the county, which is the fastest growing in the country with the most diverse and the youngest population in the State. It is also the third largest county from a population point of view.”

Mr Hunt added: ‘Fingal County Council continues to have the lowest rates cost of any of the four Dublin local authorities so we are creating a very business friendly environment. We’ve been able to secure the additional expenditure without

overburdening the rate payer or the LPT payers. The LPT adjustment meant less than a 50 cent per week rise for 80 per cent of households in the county. “

Mr Hunt added that the three-year capital plan sets out an investment of just under €600m which is a substantial investment that will be bolstered by a €70m EIB facility.

Concluding, he said Budget 2019 would maintain the Council’s enhanced level of investment to improve service delivery, as well as developing the economic and community plan for Fingal that supports job creation, tourism and sustainable communities.



# Library visits pass the one million mark

Over one million visits were made to Fingal Libraries last year as Fingal County Council continues to invest heavily in this key area.

In its 2017 Performance Indicators Report, NOAC (National Oversight & Audit Committee) records that Fingal spent €41.72 per head of population on providing library services in 2017 and a similar figure was recorded in 2018. This is 34% greater than the national average of €31 per person.

This spend facilitates free access to books and to a wide range of electronic resources including newspapers, magazines and online courses, to a programme of activities and events which informs and entertains as well as access to spaces in which people meet, engage, create and learn.

It's major capital project is the Swords Civic and Cultural Centre which will include a new County Library alongside a Theatre. Capital funding is also in place in 2019 to start the extension and refurbishment to Skerries Library.

Fingal Libraries operates a range of services through its 10 branches, four new mobile vans and its Local Studies and Archive section.

## Economic and

Tourism promotion and economic development is a key element of Fingal County Council's annual budget as it continues to promote the region as a place to visit and do business.

One of the most significant events is the annual Flavours of Fingal Festival, which last year attracted tens of thousands of people to Newbridge House. In fact, it is estimated that the two-day Flavours of Fingal event resulted in €3.1m of economic output in 2018.

Overall it is estimated that up to €0.5 billion per year is spent by visitors in Fingal, which, in turn, supports 20,000 jobs.

Fingal County Council is strongly committed to the economic development of Fingal through its Economic Enterprise and Tourism Development Department, which is solely focused on economic development. Indeed an additional sum of €850,000 has been ring-fenced to support enhanced expenditure in events, tourism activities and heritage properties within the county in 2019.

Fingal County Council actively supports and promotes a broad range of arts activity in Fingal, in particular the funding of events and performances.

The Council's two Arts Centres, Draíocht in Blanchardstown and the Seamus Ennis Arts Centre in Naul, continue to prosper and €710,000 is provided for their continued support in 2019. These arts centres are beacons of culture and centres of excellence for the Arts in Fingal.

In 2019 a sum of €150,000 is provided for Arts Grants which support a wide range of cultural activities throughout Fingal.

## Council spends €4.4m maintaining public lights

Some €4.4m will be spent by Fingal County Council maintaining over 32,000 public lights across the region in 2019. Included in this figure is energy provision for 2,400 lights and

traffic route lighting on the M1, M2 and N3 national primary roads. Fingal County Council plans to spend €120,200 for minor works. A sum of €2.4m has been provided in the capital

account to accelerate the LED public lighting replacement programme which will now be completed in just over two years as opposed to the original seven-year timeline.

## Community at the heart of all the council does

**M**ore than one million people used Fingal County Council's community centres in the first nine months of 2018.

Fingal supports 31 community facilities across

the county and some €400,000 has been ring-fenced in the 2019 Budget to allow the local authority provide additional funding for remedial and refurbishment works on community centres across the region.

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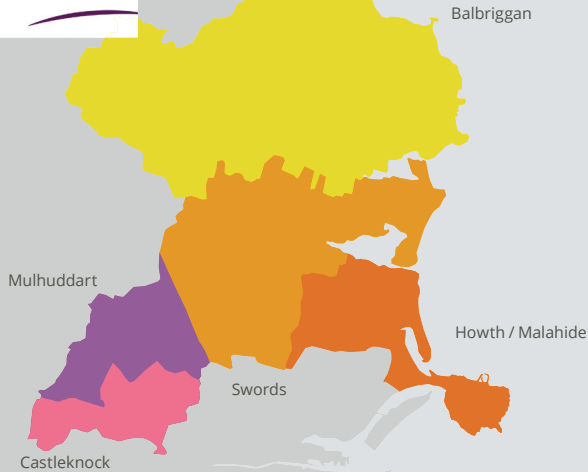

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## Sháraigh líon na gcuairtenna ar leabharlanna milliún cuairt sa bhliain 2018

Tugadh níos mó na milliún cuairt ar Leabharlanna Fhine Gall anuraidh, agus leanann Comhairle Contae Fhine Gall le hinfheistiocht mhór a dhéanamh sa réimse tábhachtach seo. Chuir an Coimisiún Náisiúnta Maoirseachta agus Iniúchóireachta (CNMI) ar taifead, ina thuarascáil bhliantúil ar tháscairí feidhmíochta don bhliain 2017, gur chaith Fine Gall €41.72 an duine chun seirbhísí leabharlainne a chur ar fáil sa bhliain 2017, agus taifeadadh figiúr cosúil leis sin sa bhliain 2018. Tá sé seo 34% níos airde ná an meánlíon náisiúnta €31 an duine.

Éascaíonn an caiteachas seo rochtain shaor ar leabhair agus réimse leathan acmhainní leictreonacha, nuachtáin, irisí agus cúrsaí ar líne ina measc, agus ar chlár gníomhaíochtaí agus imeachtaí a chuireann daoine ar an eolas agus a dhéanann siamsa dóibh. Cuirtear spásanna ar fáil chomh maith inar féidir le daoine teacht le chéile, cumarsáid a dhéanamh, cruthú agus foghlaim. Is é an tlonad Cultúir agus Pobail sa Sord an mórthionscadal caipitil atá ar siúl, áit a mbeidh Leabharlann Chontae nua chomh maith le hAmharclann. 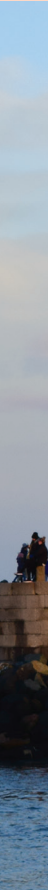

# LEAGANN STRAITÉIS UAILLMHIANACH BONN LÁIDIR LE BORRADH A CHUR FAOI FHINE GALL

Mhéadaigh Comhairle Contae Fhine Gall caiteachas faoi €20 milliún sa dá bhliain roimhe seo, agus is ionann agus €237 milliún an caiteachas iomlán sa bhliain 2019. Rinneadh é seo mar chuid de straitéis uailmhianach agus forleathan chun bonn láidir a leagan ionas go bhfásfaidh an réigiún mar áit le cónaí ann, cuairt a thabhairt air agus gnó a dhéanamh ann.

Sin a dúirt an Ceannasaí Airgeadais Oliver Hunt atá i mbun an sparáin don údarás áitiúil go laethúil. Dúirt sé chomh maith go gcoimeádfaidh Buiséad 2019 an infheistíocht mhéadaithe a rinneadh i mBuiséad 2018, agus go gcuirfidh sé léi.

Tá Buiséad bliantúil Chomhairle Contae Fhine Gall ag dul i méid go leanúnach le blianta beaga anuas. Méhadaigh an buiséad ó €216 milliún sa bhliain 2017 go €237 milliún i mbliana, ar



méadú 10 faoin gcéad é sin.

Dúirt an tUasal Hunt go raibh Comhairle Contae Fhine Gall ag atógáil a cuid cúrsaí airgeadais le deis a thabhairt chun infheistíocht níos mó agus níos suntasaí a dhéanamh sa réigiún. “Sa bhliain 2018, mhéadaíomar ár gcaiteachas faoi €10 milliún agus beidh €10 milliún sa bhreis le hinfheistiú againn sa bhliain 2019.

Dúirt an tUasal Hunt: “An bhliain seo caite, chuireamar tús le straitéis dhá bhliain chun infheistíocht shuntasach a dhéanamh sa réigiún. Thosaíomar sa bhliain 2018 trí Cháin Mhaoine Áitiúil (CMÁ) a athrú, rud a chuir €2 milliún

sa bhreis de mhaoiniú ar fáil. Imfhálaíodh an t-airgead sin do roinnt réimsí tábhachtacha.

“Chaitheamar súil ar rátaí chomh maith. Laghdaíodh rátaí go suntasach go luath sna 2010idí nuair a thacaíomar le cuideachtaí le linn tréimhse dheacair eacnamaíochta.

Tá feabhas mór tagtha ar an ngeilleagar ó shin i leith. Cuireadh an t-airgead breise ar leataobh le haghaidh roinnt tionscadal, cosúil le soilsiú poiblí, trácht, cosáin, oibreacha feabhais agus athchóirithe ar ionaid phobail, agus chun cistiú a chur ar fáil d'oibreacha caipitiúla ar ár soláthar tithíochta, feabhsúcháin ar chórais téimh agus oibreacha eile feabhais ina measc.”

Sa bhliain 2019, leanfaidh Comhairle Contae Fhine Gall ar aghaidh leis an straitéis sin. Cuirfidh leis an obair sin tríd an athrú ar CMÁ agus an méadú ar rátaí a chuirfidh €2.5

milliún sa bhreis de mhaoiniú ar fáil. Déanfaimid an t-airgead sin a imfháil le haghaidh roinnt tionscadal tábhachtach sa réigiún.

Cuireadh an t-airgead ar leataobh le haghaidh gníomhaíochtaí ar leith i réimsí a bhaineann le tithíocht agus easpa dídine, an pobal, oibríochtaí, turasóireacht agus imeachtaí, ár n-ionaid réadmhaoine oidhreachta san áireamh, agus ár leabharlanna.

Dúirt sé: “Is réimsí tábhachtacha iad sin, de réir muintir an réigiúin, agus is gníomhaíochtaí iad ina bhféachaimid chun cinn. Fuair eamar aiseolas an-dearfach go dtí seo, mar is léir do dhaoine cén áit ar caitheadh an t-airgead. Mar shampla, bhí an fhéile Blas Fhine Gall ar cheann de na

réimsí sin. Ba imeacht é sin a raibh rath mór air i rith an tsamhraidh.

Dúirt an tUasal Hunt: “Is é bunús na straitéise seo ná infheistíocht a dhéanamh sa chontae seo, ar an contae is mó atá ag fás sa tír é agus a bhfuil an daonra is éagsúla agus is óige sa Stát aige. Is é an tríú contae is mó sa tír é, ó thaobh daonra de, chomh maith.”

Dúirt an tUasal Hunt chomh maith: “Tá na rátaí atá ag Comhairle Contae Fhine Gall fós i measc na rátaí is ísle atá ag aon cheann de na ceithre údarás áitiúla i mBaile Átha Cliath. Mar sin, cuirimid timpeallacht atá an-fhabhrach do ghnó ar fáil. Bhíomar ábalta caiteachas sa bhreis a fháil gan ualach róthrom a chur ar na hÍocóirí rátaí ná ar na hÍocóirí

CMÁ. Ní raibh ach méadú a bhí níos lú na 50 cent in aghaidh na seachtaine i gceist do 80 faoin gcéad de theaghligh mar gheall ar an athrú ar cháin mhaoine áitiúil.”

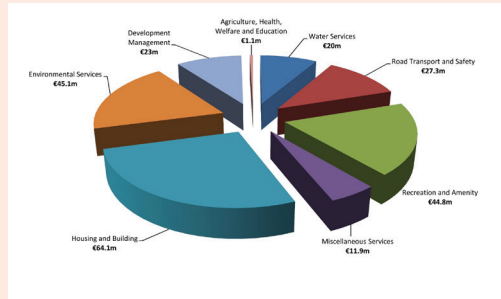


# Ceadaíodh buiséad €237 milliún don bhliain 2019

Caithfidh Comhairle Contae Fhine Gall €237 milliún, arb ionann é sin agus €801 in aghaidh an duine den daonra, sa bhliain 2019 le seirbhísí agus infheistíocht a sholáthar a bhfuil mar aidhm acu feabhas a chur ar an gcontae mar áit le cónaí, le bheith ag obair, agus le hinfheistíocht a dhéanamh inti.

Ó 2012 i leith, mhéadaigh an Buiséad reatha ó €212 milliún go €237 milliún, ar méadú 10 faoin gcéad é sin. Tíocfaidh méadú €10 milliún ar chaiteachas i mbuiséad na bliana 2019 i gcomparáid le 2018, bliain inar tháinig méadú €10 milliún ar chaiteachas chomh maith.

Anuas air sin, coinneofar leibhéal ard infheistíochta na Comhairle ar an leibhéal céanna chun soláthar seirbhíse a fheabhsú, chomh maith leis an bplean eacnamaíochta agus pobail d'Fhine Gall a fhorbairt, plean a thacaíonn le cruthú fostaíochta, turasóireacht agus pobail



inbhuanaithe.

Ina theannta sin, faoina Clár Caipitil trí bliana 2019-2021 a comhaontaíodh i nDeireadh Fómhair, caithfidh Comhairle Contae Fhine Gall €588.68 milliún sa bhreis ar 212 tionscadal aonair ar fud an chontae.

Déantar an buiséad €237 milliún, ar comhaontaíodh na comhairleoirí leis, a roinnt mar a leanas:

Ghlac comhairleoirí leis go dtiocfaidh méadú dhá faoin gcéad ar rátaí tráchtála. Dá bharr

sin, déanfar €2.5 milliún a imfháil le haghaidh infheistíocht bhreise i nglantachán sráideanna, cothabháil

páirceanna agus gníomhaíochtaí oibríúcháin eile.

Dáilfear thart ar €400,000 ar ionaid phobail le haghaidh oibreacha feabhais agus athchóirithe. Cuirfear €700,000 sa bhreis ar fáil le haghaidh infheistíocht fheabhsaithe in imeachtaí pobail agus áiseanna. Gheobhaidh an Oifig Ealaíon €0.25 milliún le haghaidh tuilleadh infheistíochta a dhéanamh in áiseanna, deontais agus gníomhaíochtaí ealaíon, agus cuireadh €850,000 ar leataobh le haghaidh infheistíocht mhéadaithe in imeachtaí, gníomhaíochtaí turasóireachta agus ionaid réadmhaoine oidhreachta.
