



ROADS ACT 1993 TO 2023 – SECTION 75 TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE OF STATION ROAD (R106), SUTTON, DUBLIN 13.

Fingal County Council has made an order for the temporary road closure of **Station Road (R106), Sutton, Dublin 13**, from the junction of Sutton Cross, Strand Road/The Mall and Main Street Baldoyle, following an application from Iarnród Éireann.

The purpose of this closure is to facilitate works to the Station Road railway crossing.

The period of the temporary closure will be from **11.30p.m. Saturday 22nd June 2024 to 06.30 a.m. Monday 24th June 2024**.

One submission was received during the consultation process.

The alternative routes available for traffic during the closure hours are as follows:

Direction of Travel	Destination	Alternative Routes
From Sutton Cross	Baldoyle	Dublin Road and Baldoyle Road (R809)
From Baldoyle	Sutton	Baldoyle Road (R809) onto the Dublin Road
From Lauders Lane junction with Station Road	Baldoyle	Station Road to Sutton Cross onto the Dublin Road & Baldoyle Road (R809) and vice versa

There will be no through access through the railway crossing for vehicles, pedestrians and cyclists.

Local vehicular access only will be provided for Station Road from Sutton Cross and Strand Road.
