



ROADS ACT 1993 TO 2023 – SECTION 75

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF DRYNAM FOOTBRIDGE, SWORDS, CO. DUBLIN

Fingal County Council has made an Order to temporarily close Drynam Footbridge, Swords, Co. Dublin for the purpose of resurfacing works. It is proposed that the footbridge will be **closed for 24 hours per day during the period 15th of July 2024 to 29th of July 2024.**

Permitted working hours shall be between 07:00hrs and 19:00hrs Monday to Friday.

No works are permitted on Saturdays, Sundays and Bank Holidays.

One submission was made during the consultation process.

Alternative route available for pedestrians are as follows, dependant on direction of travel.

Pedestrians travelling East from Pavillions will have to divert to the Chapel Lane Footbridge, access can be gained through Longlands Estate, taking a left at Castle Avenue and then right at Chapel Lane.

Pedestrians travelling West to Pavillions will have to divert using the pedestrian walkway alongside Ashley Avenue.
