



ROADS ACT 1993 TO 2023 – SECTION 75

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF DONABATE DISTRIBUTOR ROAD (R126) FROM ITS JUNCTION WITH THE HEARSE ROAD (L2170) TO ITS JUNCTION WITH PORTRANE ROAD, DONABATE (L2170), CO. DUBLIN

An application has been received from Glenveagh Homes for permission to temporarily close the **Donabate Distributor Road (R126) from its junction with the Hearse Road (L2170) to its junction with Portrane Road, Donabate (L2170) Co. Dublin** for the purpose of a 4-way signalised junction upgrade to facilitate segregated cycle and pedestrian crossings in line with the latest Transport Infrastructure Ireland specification. It is proposed that the road will be **closed from 12th of August 2024 to 30th of August 2024 for 24 hours per day.**

Permitted working hours shall be between **07:00hrs and 22:00hrs Monday to Saturday.**

Alternative route available for vehicular traffic is as follows;

Traffic heading South on R126 from Portrane will be diverted onto the L2170 Portrane road into Donabate village and rejoin the R126 via Chapel View/New Road or Hearse Road.

Traffic heading North on the R126 Donabate Distributor Road will be diverted via New Road into Main Street Donabate then on to the L2170 Portrane road to rejoin the R126.

Local access will be maintained at all times. Emergency Services access will also be made available in the event of an emergency.
