



ROADS ACT 1993 TO 2023 – SECTION 75 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF MILL STREET FROM GEORGE’S HILL TO HARBOUR ROAD, BALBRIGGAN, CO. DUBLIN

Fingal County Council has made an Order to temporarily close **Mill Street from George’s Hill to Harbour Road, Balbriggan, Co. Dublin** for the purpose of drainage works and construction of new rigid pavements for the Quay Street Project. It is proposed that the road will be **closed from 14th of August 2024 to 30th of January 2025 for 24 hours per day.**

Permitted working hours shall be between **08:00hrs and 19:00hrs Monday to Friday.** No works shall take place on Saturdays, Sundays and Bank Holidays.

No submissions were made during the consultation process.

Alternative route available for vehicular traffic exiting the locked gate to Front Strand Beach is as follows;

Traffic heading to Harbour Road from Front Strand Beach will be diverted onto Mill Street, then turn left onto R132 Drogheda Street, and then turn left onto Quay Street to rejoin Harbour Road.

Local access will be maintained at all times. Emergency Services access will also be made available in the event of an emergency.
