RE : PROPOSED TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF CASTLEKNOCK ROAD, COLLEGE ROAD, WHITE'S ROAD TO FACILITATE THE ROUTE OF DUBLIN HALF-MARATHON RACE.

Dear Sir/Madam,

An application has been received by Marathon Events DAC for permission to temporarily close the following roads **Castleknock Road, College Road, Whites Road, all Dublin 15**. The closure is necessary to facilitate the route of the Dublin Half-Marathon Road Race to be held on **Sunday 22nd September 2024 from 8am to 1pm**.

The dates/times for road closure is:

Castleknock Road (R806) closed from Castleknock Gate at Phoenix Park to junction with College Road from 08.30am to 09.45am Sunday 22nd September 2024

College Road from junction at Castleknock Road to Whites Road at junction with College Road/Carpenterstown Road closed from 08.30am to 09.45am Sunday 22nd September 2024

Whites Road closed from 08.30am to 10am Sunday 22nd September 2024

Diversions:

- For traffic travelling from Dublin City direction, at Ashtown Roundabout continue on N3 and use Auburn Avenue for local access up to the junction with Castleknock Road (closed).
- For access to Castleknock Village continue on N3 to Blanchardstown (The Bell) and travel eastbound along R806 back on Castleknock Road up as far as junction with College Road.
- For traffic travelling from Castleknock direction to Dublin City, travel towards Blanchardstown direction, access N3 at The Bell junction and take N3 in citybound direction.
- Emergency access will be maintained.
