ROADS ACT 1993 TO 2023 – SECTION 75 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF THORNLEIGH SQUARE IN SWORDS, CO. DUBLIN

Fingal County Council's Active Travel Department has made an order to temporarily close Thornleigh Square in Swords, Co. Dublin for the purpose of facilitating a school road festival event. It is proposed that the road will be **closed on Friday the 27th of September 2024 from 8.00am until 2.15pm**.

No submissions were made during the consultation process.

Alternative routes available for vehicular traffic are as follows:

Traffic north of the Road Closure at Thornleigh Educate Together National School wishing to travel south along Thornleigh Square towards Glen Ellan Road: Traffic should travel south along Thornleigh Square and turn left at the junction with Thornleigh Green. Turn right and travel south along Thornleigh Road and continue south on to Bramley Terrace. At the end of Bramley Terrace turn right onto Applewood Main Street and continue southwest towards Thornleigh Square, take the left turn for the roundabout with Glen Ellan Road. From there you can turn left for Swords via Glen Ellan Road and Balheary Road or turn right along Glen Ellan Road and travel west towards Glen Ellan.

Traffic South of the Road Closure at Thornleigh Educate Together National School wishing to travel North along Thornleigh Square towards Broadmeadow Park: Traffic should travel south along Thornleigh Square to the junction with Applewood Main Street and turn right. Travel southeast along Applewood main Street and take the left turn for Bramley Terrace. Travel north on Bramley Terrace continuing to Thornleigh Road. Turn left on to Thornleigh Green and continue straight to the junction with Thornleigh Square, take the right turn to continue towards Broadmeadow Park.

Local access will be maintained at all times. Emergency services access will also be made available in the event of an emergency.
