



ROADS ACT 1993 TO 2023 – SECTION 75

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF BATTER LANE, BALHEARY, CO. DUBLIN

Fingal County Council has made an Order to temporarily close Batter Lane, Balheary, Co. Dublin for the purpose of ESB ducting works. It is proposed that the road will be **closed from 24th of September 2024 to 18th of October 2024 for 24 hours per day.**

Permitted working hours shall be between **08:00hrs and 21:30hrs Monday to Friday and 09:00hrs and 16:30hrs on Saturdays.**

No works shall take place on Sundays and Bank Holidays.

No submissions were made during the consultation process.

Batter Lane will be closed from the roundabout at R132 Lanestown Turvey up to the junction with the Balheary Road.

Alternative routes available for vehicular traffic are as follows:

Motorists travelling from the R132 will continue straight via the R132 towards Swords until the Estuary Roundabout then turn right onto R125 and continue until the junction with Balheary Road then turn right onto Balheary Road and continue straight towards Jamestown ending their diversion route.

Motorists travelling from Jamestown will continue straight via Balheary Road until they reach the junction with the R125 then turn left towards Malahide until the Estuary Roundabout then turn left onto R132 (Belfast Direction) continue travelling North straight above the M1 continue on R132 towards Lusk ending their diversion route on the Roundabout.

Local access will be maintained at all times. Emergency services access will also be made available in the event of an emergency.
