What Do I Need?

- The Freegal App.
- A valid Fingal Library card and PIN.



How Do I Get Started?

- Download the Freegal app.
- When asked for a location, type in Fingal.
- When Fingal Libraries appears, confirm.
- Login with library card number and PIN.
- Terms and conditions appear.
- Add your email address when prompted.

Ways to Search


- Simply tap the Search icon.
- Use the search field at the top of the *genre* pages. Here, you
 can locate songs that fit your interests like pop, classical, jazz,
 hip-hop...etc. Explore the sub-genres too.
- Browse featured banners on the Home Page: What's Hot, Now Trending, New Arrivals, Discover Albums, Explore Playlists, Discover Artists, Spotlight...etc.
- To stream a song, simply click on the play arrow. Streaming is unlimited.

How Do I Download Songs?

- Tap the three dots to the right of a song and use the download link.
- Songs are only available to download on an individual basis.
 Entire albums cannot be downloaded but you can download songs on an album over time.
- If you start a download and then cancel it, it still counts as a download. We recommend using the song samples to ensure you're downloading a song you want.
- In My Music/My Downloads, you can see all the music you've downloaded.

How Do I Create a Playlist?

- Tap the three dots to the right of a song and use the Add to
 Playlist or Create a Playlist options.
- Create and view your playlists in My Music.



How Do I Manage Content?

- The easiest way is to use the Menu option.
- Browse by Genre or simply search by artist.
- My Music shows your playlists and wish-lists.
- It also shows your favourites and downloads.
- You can also search from My Music.
- Go to your created playlists from My Playlists.
- Downloads brings you straight to your music library.
- The FAQ section is great; we recommend you read it.

Overview

- Download limits are reset every Monday.
- The music you access is for personal, non-commercial purposes only.
- Due to licensing agreements, some songs are download only.
- If you run out of downloads, add songs to your *Wishlist* and save them. You might want to download later.
- Freegal is unable to restore music that has been lost once downloaded to your device. We recommend backing up your files.
- Don't forget, you can stream as much content as you like it's unlimited. Only downloads are limited.

Anyone can join the library by registering online: https://www.fingal.ie/council/service/join-library
Once registered, you can use e-services immediately, including Freegal. Within 30 days you'll need to visit a branch library with ID (photo and address) to get your library card. The card allows you to borrow books, audiobooks, games, DVDs and a whole lot more!
