



ROADS ACT 1993 TO 2023 – SECTION 75

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF THE R122, NAUL ROAD, CO. DUBLIN

Fingal County Council has made an order to temporarily close The R122, Naul Road, Co. Dublin for the purpose facilitating road resurfacing works. It is proposed that the road will be **closed from 7th of October 2024 to 18th of November 2024 between 20:00hrs and 06:00hrs.**

The road will reopen daily from 06:00hrs until 20:00hrs to allow traffic through.

No submissions were made during the consultation process.

Alternative routes available for vehicular traffic are as follows:

Westerly:

Traffic approaching westerly along the R122 will be informed to divert at the first exist of the roundabout of M1 Junction 6 onto the M1 travelling south. Taking the slip road off the M1 at junction 5, take the first exit of the approaching roundabout towards Balbriggan. Once at the next roundabout, take the third exit onto the R132 towards Lusk. Travelling for approximately 1 kilometre, take the slip road off the R132 towards Man O'War / Garristown. At the approaching roundabout, take the third exit to cross the R132 overpass. Once at the next roundabout, take the first exit towards Walshestown / Carristown travelling approximately 4.5 kilometres until you reach the Jamestown / Rathgreat junction. Turn right at this junction towards the Naul. Travelling north on the R108 for approximately 3.5 Kilometres until you reach the Naul ending their diversion route.

Easterly:

Traffic approaching south exiting the Naul, travel approximately 3.5 kilometres along the R108 until you reach the Jamestown/Rathgreat Junction. Turn left towards Lusk for approximately 4.5 kilometres until you reach the oncoming roundabout. Take the second exit leading directly onto the R132 towards Balbriggan. Travelling approximately 1 kilometre along the R132, take the first exit off the roundabout towards the junction 5, M1. Take the second exit of the oncoming roundabout leading you over the M1 overpass. At the next roundabout, take the third exit onto the M1 travelling north for approximately 1 kilometre. Take the slip road at M1 junction 6 and take the third exit of the roundabout travelling over the M1 overpass. At the oncoming roundabout, take the second exit towards Balbriggan ending their diversion route.

Local access will be maintained at all times. Emergency services access will also be made available in the event of an emergency.
