



ROADS ACT 1993 TO 2023 – SECTION 75

PROPOSED TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF

DUBLIN ROAD IN LUSK, CO. DUBLIN

Fingal County Council is proposing to temporarily close Dublin Road in Lusk for the purpose of facilitating site investigation works & alterations to the existing Stormwater Network. Dublin Road will be closed from **6th January 2025 until 28th February 2025 from 9am until 5pm.**

Alternative routes available for vehicular traffic are as follows:

Traffic travelling to Dublin Road Lusk from South:

Traffic travelling from the R127 divert via the Dublin Road Roundabout onto the Rathmore Road (R127). Alternatively, traffic can divert via Barrack Lane onto Treen Hill.

Traffic travelling to Dublin Road Lusk from North:

Traffic travelling from Main Street towards Dublin Road. Continue through junction towards Station Road and onto the Rathmore Road (R127) towards Dublin.

Advance signage will inform traffic of diversion route and road closure.

Local Access for emergency services and residents along Dublin Road will be maintained at all times throughout the road closure.
