



ROADS ACT 1993 TO 2023 – SECTION 75

PROPOSED TEMPORARY CLOSURE

OF GEORGE'S HILL, BALBRIGGAN,

CO. DUBLIN

An application has been received from Diamond Kleen Plus LTD for permission to temporarily close **George's Hill, Balbriggan, Co. Dublin** for the purpose of facilitating power washing the exterior boundary walls of residential apartment blocks. It is proposed that George's Hill will be **closed from 27th January 2025 until 3rd February 2025 from 8am until 4pm.**

Alternative routes available for vehicular traffic are as follows:

Traffic travelling to Drogheda Street/R132, will be diverted to Mill Street, then right onto Drogheda Street/R132 where the diversion ends.

Access to Balbriggan Station is available via Railway Street.

Local Access for emergency services and residents along George's Hill, Balbriggan will be maintained at all times throughout the road closure.
