

TRAVELLING TO FINGAL

Irish Rail commuter services to Dundalk & Drogheda also serve the following towns along the route; Malahide, Donabate, Rush & Lusk, Balbriggan & Skerries. The Dart serves Malahide & Howth directly and venues are within walking distance of the stations. The Swords Express has a regular service between Dublin City Centre & Swords Village. Dublin 15 can be serviced by Dublin Bus and Irish Rail commuter services via the Maynooth train line.

TradFest in association with the NTA will supply a shuttle bus connecting Malahide Train Station to Swords Castle, Argillan Castle & The Seamus Ennis Arts Centre. Please keep an eye on our social media channels which will have regular and detailed updates on how to get around
