TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF NUMBER OF ROADS IN LUSK, RUSH AND SKERRIES TO FACILITATE ST. PATRICK'S DAY PARADES ON MONDAY 17TH MARCH 2025

Lusk Community Council, Rush Community Council and Skerries Chamber of Commerce proposes to hold St. Patrick's Day Parades at locations across the county on Monday 17th March 2025, and to facilitate the parade routes it is proposed to temporarily close a number of roads at the locations listed below:

| Location | Route |
|------------------|--|
| Lusk Village | From R127 Ring Road to Station Road From Station Road to Main Street From Post Office Road to The Green Lusk |
| Rush Village | Lower Main Street/Bawn Road/Kilbush Lane/Chapel Green |
| Skerries Village | From South Strand Street to Strand Street |
