TRAFFIC CALMING SCHEMES

Fingal County Council in exercise of the powers conferred under Section 38 of the Road Traffic Act, 1994 and Section 46 of the Public Transport Regulation Act, 2009 hereby gives notice that it has prepared a Scheme for the provision of traffic calming measures at the following locations:

- o **Naul Village, Co. Dublin.** - 2 No. Flat Top Traffic Calming Ramps. & 1 No. Raised Zebra Pedestrian Crossing

The scheme includes the provision of traffic calming ramps, appropriate road signage and road markings where necessary.
