



ROADS ACT 1993 TO 2023 – SECTION 75

PROPOSED TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF SUNDRIVE ROAD, RUSH, CO. DUBLIN

An application has been received from GMC Utilities Ltd on behalf of Uisce Éireann for permission to temporarily close Sundrive Road, Rush, Co. Dublin for the purpose of carrying out a permanent reinstatement of sewer connection. It is proposed that the road will be closed on **22nd April 2025 from 8am until 6pm.**

Alternative routes available for vehicular traffic are as follows:

Traffic travelling to Sundrive road from the West:

Travel along Sundrive Road and take left onto Golf Road. Drive to the end and turn right onto Sandy Road and continue onto Upper main street. Take the first right onto Hands Lane where you will meet the crossroads with Sundrive road.

Traffic travelling to Sundrive road from the East:

Travel along Sundrive Road and take left onto Hands Lane. At the T- junction take a right onto South Shore Road. Turn right at the crossroads onto Sandy Lane where you will meet the crossroads with Sundrive Road.

Local access to be maintained for Sandy Lane at all times. Emergency services access will also be made available in the event of an emergency.
