TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF NUMBER OF ROADS IN LUSK, RUSH AND SKERRIES TO FACILITATE ST. PATRICK'S DAY PARADES ON MONDAY 17TH MARCH 2025

Fingal County Council has made an Order to temporarily close **a number of roads in Lusk, Rush and Skerries Co. Dublin** following applications from Lusk Community Council, Rush Community Council and Skerries Chamber of Commerce.

The purpose of the closures is to facilitate St. Patrick's Day Parades on Monday 17th March 2025 at locations across the county. In order to facilitate the parade routes, it is proposed to temporarily close a number of roads at the locations listed below:

Location	Route
Lusk Village	From R127 Ring Road to Station Road From Station Road to Main Street From Post Office Road to The Green Lusk
Rush Village	Lower Main Street/Bawn Road/Kilbush Lane/Chapel Green
Skerries Village	From South Strand Street to Strand Street

Emergency access will be maintained at all times and local access will be facilitated on a rolling basis.
